FOREST ORDER

USDA FOREST SERVICE GRAND MESA, UNCOMPAHGRE and GUNNISON NATIONAL FORESTS GUNNISON RANGER DISTRICT

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551, and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the described area on the Gunnison Ranger District of the Grand Mesa, Uncompanger and Gunnison National Forests, Gunnison County, State of Colorado (the "Restricted Road"), as depicted on the map hereby attached and incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

The Restricted Road is located in sections 2 and 11, Township 50 North, Range 5 East, New Mexico Principal Meridian, and includes the highlighted portion of the Restricted Road. The Restricted Road is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Using a motor vehicle on the Restricted Road [36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded or until June 15, 2019, whichever event occurs first.


